INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Bill No. 12-25 (Pay and Classification Plan) was introduced by Council President Boniface at the request of the County Executive:

AN EMERGENCY ACT to repeal the Harford County Pay Plan and Classification Plan, Harford County Ordinance No. 11-20, as amended, and to enact a new Harford County Pay Plan and Classification Plan to stand in lieu of the Ordinance repealed; to provide a pay plan for County employees; to further provide for new position plans and salary grades for County classified and exempt employees; all in accordance with Section 603 of the Charter; and to provide that this act shall not be codified in the Harford County Code.


